duly sworn upon oath depose and say that I am now and have been a resident of Madison County Iowa, for 50 years last past, and that I am a son of William Fenimore who died intestate in Jasper County, Missouri, on or about September 13, 1917. I further state that said William Fenimore was survived by his widow, Mollie E. Fenimore, and by William E. Fenimore and Helen M. Fenimore, and Newton Fenimore, Annon Fenimore, Anderson Fenimore, Willard Fenimore, (this affiant), Joseph Fenimore, Elmer Fenimore, Rhoda A. Schoenenberger and Lillie E. Waechter and Daisy G. Greger and Effie E. Essex, his children and sole and only heirs at law; that he left no other child, no issue of any deceased child and no adopted child.

I further state that the Estate of said William Fenimore was duly administered upon in Jasper County, Missouri, in accordance with the Laws of the State of Missouri, and that all debts and claims against said estate have been fully paid, including expenses of last sickness and funeral expenses.
