WHEREAS, Mary Etta Petrie and John Petrie, her husband, did execute and deliver unto

J.E. Hamilton a certain mortgage and the note therein set forth, said mortgage bearing date the 11th day of February, 1918, recorded on the 2nd day of March 1918, in Book 60 of Mortgages on page 217 of the records of Madison County, Iowa; and

WHEREAS, J.J. Slater and Anna Slater, his wife, the present owners of the property described in said mortgage, and Christine Wiese, the present owner of said mortgage, have this day agreed to extend the time of payment of the principal debt secured by said mortgage; NOW, THEREFORE, for value received, it is hereby agreed that the principal sum now fully and justly unpaid on said mortgage is Four Thousand (\$4000) Dollars, and that the same draws interest and is to draw interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable annually, to be computed from the 1st day of March, 1923, and said principal sum shall be due and payable upon the 1st day of March, 1928, at which time said J.J. Slater and Anna Slater hereby assume and agree to pay the same with all proper interest at the office of Jebens & Butenschoen in Davenport, Iowa, reserving, however, the right to pay \$100 or any multiples thereof on said principal sum on any interest date on and after March 1, 1925.

It is also mutually agreed that all and any terms, conditions and stipulations in said mortgage and note contained and set forth, are and shall be furthermore of full force and effect, excepting only as modified by the foregoing stipulations.
