ORDINANCE NO.55. An ordinance vacating 20 feet off east side of Chestnut street south from
C.R.I. & P.R.R. to Iowa Avenue.
Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Earlham, Iowa.
Section 1. That the east 20 ft. of Chestnut street lying between the Chicago Rock Island &
Pacific Railroad right-of-way and Iowa Avenue, all within the original town of Earlham, Iowa,
be and the same is hereby vacated.
Section 2. The Mayor and Town Clerk are hereby authorized to exchange the south 160 lineal
feet thus vacated to Andrew Requist for the north 20 feet of Lot 7, Block 15 of the original
town of Earlham, Iowa, and convey the same by quit claim deed.
Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the foregoing ordinance
are hereby repealed.
Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and pub-
lication as provided by law. Passed and approved this 21st day of Feb., 1916.
