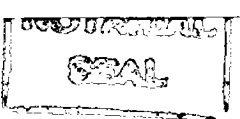

Whereas, on the 9th day of July, 1919, William E. Shambaugh executed and delivered to The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company a note in the sum of fifteen thousand dollars secured by a mortgage of even date therewith upon certain real estate situated in Madison County, Iowa, recorded in said County on July 19, 1919 in Volume 63 of Mortgages, on page 253 and there remains unpaid of the principal of said note the sum of fifteen thousand dollars with interest from July 9, 1924; and Whereas, title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in William E. Shambaugh subject to said mortgage; and subject to a junior mortgage to A. H. Shambaugh and Whereas, said Insurance Company has been requested to extend the time of payment of said note and mortgage as hereinafter stated, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided; Now Therefore, the said William E. Shambaugh hereby agrees to pay the principal sum remaining unpaid as aforesaid on July 9, 1929 with the privilege, at any time after July 9, 1926 and before maturity, of paying \$100, or any multiple thereof, upon said principal, provided that sixty days additional interest shall be paid on any and all such payments in excess of one-half of the principal sum; and said party also agrees to pay interest on the said sum of fifteen thousand dollars July 9, 1924 until paid at the rate of five and one-fourth per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually.

And the parties hereto hereby agree that said note and mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises and shall remain in force, with all their covenants and conditions, except as herein modified. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the said William E. Shambaugh and Carrie Shambaugh, his wife, and A. H. Shambaugh have hereunto set their hands this seventh day of August, A.D., 1924
