This release is made, executed and delivered pursuant to authority given by the Board of Directors of said Corporation Illinois State Bank of Quincy.

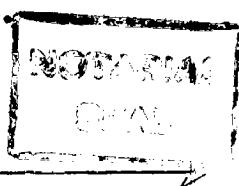
