That at a meeting of said trustees, it was ordered by said Board of Trustees that the  
Church buildings situated upon the following described real estate, to-wit:

Commencing at the South East corner of Lots Thirteen (13) in Hutchings Addition to  
Winterset, Iowa, running thence North Sixty-six (66) feet, thence West Sixty-six (66) feet,  
thence South Sixty-six (66) feet, thence East Sixty-six (66) feet to the place of beginning  
be sold and removed from said property. That said property had ceased to be used for  
church purposes and that the said Board of Trustees were vested with the right to sell and  
dispose of the buildings, when not used for Church purposes, That this affiant was di-  
rected and authorized by said Board of Trustees to dispose of said property, and that he as  
such Trustee sold the buildings, and by the acts of said Board, all the rights of said
