AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION. WHEREAS, George W. Abrams, single, did on the 20th day of

October, 1913, execute and deliver to Bankers Life Company a certain mortgage which was recorded in book 57 on page 22 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, to secure the payment of a certain note for \$6000.00 and interest; now George W. Abrams the present owner of the premises described in said mortgage, and the Bankers Life Company the present owner of said note and mortgage, do by these presents agree that the principal sum due thereon is Five Thousand Dollars, and that the same shall bear interest at the rate of five per cent per annum, from December 1, 1923, payable semi-annually, on the first days of June and December of each year and that the principal sum shall become due on the first day of December, 1928, at which time the said George W. Abrams hereby assumes and agrees to pay the same with interest at the office of the Bankers Life Company, Des Moines, Iowa. It is further agreed that all the terms, conditions and stipulations contained in said note and mortgage shall continue in full force and effect excepting only as modified by this agreement. One hundred dollars or multiple thereof may be paid at any interest date on and after December 1st, 1925.

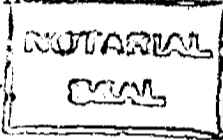

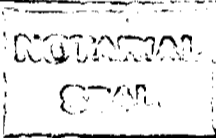
