 County, Iowa, deceased; that I am one of the owners of the East three-fourths of the South-
 east Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 9, in Township 76 North, of Range
 26 West of the 5th P.M., and a brother of Luther Russell Howell, Erwin M. Howell and Curtis W.
 Howell, who are also named as devisees in said last will and testament of Lanson Howell, de-
 ceased. That the said Curtis W. Howell is the same and identical person as the C.W. Howell
