State of Iowa, Madison County, ss: I, Judson Walker of said County and State being first duly sworn upon oath depose and say that I am now and have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, since about March 1st, 1919, and prior to that time I never lived in Madison County, Iowa, or had property of any character in said County subject to taxation.

I further state that my full name is Judson Walker, and that I have no middle name or initial.

I further state that the unpaid personal taxes shown on the records of the Treasurer of Madison County, Iowa, against J. V. Walker, for the years 1907, 1908, 1909, 1911 and 1912 of 50¢ for each year assessed in Winterset, Iowa; against J. E. Walker for the year 1903 of \$24.32 assessed in Madison Township, Madison County, Iowa; and for the year 1922 of \$20.50 assessed in St. Charles, Iowa; against J. J. Walker for the Year 1901 of \$7.05 assessed in Union Township, Madison County, Iowa; and against J. M. Walker for the year 1900 of 86¢ assessed in Grand River Township, Madison County, Iowa, are not delinquent personal taxes of mine, but are unpaid taxes of some other persons, and therefore not a lien against the East Half of Section 30, in Township 75 North, of Range 29, West of the 5th P.M. Madison County, Iowa.

I further state that there are no unpaid personal taxes assessed against me in said Madison County, and that if there are any other unpaid taxes against persons whose surname is Walker and who have an initial "J", such taxes are not unpaid taxes of mine, but of some other persons, and not a lien on said land.
