I, Mettie Abegg Doud, on oath depose and say, that I am now a resident of Des Moines, Iowa; that I was formerly a resident of Madison County, Iowa; that I am the mother of Alfred Abegg who departed this life October 11th, 1918; That my former husband, Henry Abegg died April 29, 1914. Further I, know that Alfred Abegg sold and delivered to Grant McPherrin a note secured by mortgage of \$1248.25 covering interest in land described as the "Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter and the Northwest Quarter and the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter and the South twelve acres of the North Seventeen and one-half acres of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter, all in Section Twenty-one Township Seventy-four Range Twenty-six, Madison County, Iowa."

I further say that Alfred Abegg at the time of his death was unmarried and died without issue, and that under the law I am the sole heir at law of the said deceased Alfred Abegg.
