That part of the northeast quarter of section two, in township seventy-five north, of Range twenty-eight west bounded and described as follows, viz: Beginning at a point sixty-four rods west of the northeast corner of said section; running thence west ten rods; thence south eight rods; thence east ten rods and thence north eight rods to the place of beginning, and containing half an acre more or less.

The said The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company retains its lien upon the remainder of the premises described in said mortgage, to secure the principal sum unpaid, to wit: Seventy-five hundred dollars, with all interest on the same remaining unpaid, according to the terms and conditions of said mortgage.
