State of Iowa, Madison County, ss: I, Lewis Rogers a resident of Madison County Iowa, being duly sworn upon my oath depose and swear that I was well and personally acquainted with John Lewis who owned the West Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the East Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of North West One Fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) Section Thirteen (13), Township Seventy Five (75) North of Range Twenty Seven (27) and other land in Madison County Iowa, and further depose and say that he died on or about the year 1864, or 1865, leaving no will, and leaving as his only heirs at law his widow now Sarah Lake, and his daughter Eva A. Lewis, and his son William Lewis, and I further say that his estate is fully settled and debts all paid, there being no debts outstanding to my knowledge at the time of his death, and I further state that the grantee together with the grantors, who made a quit claim deed January 24th, 1883, and filed for record

July 18th, 1893 and conveying the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & W $\frac{1}{2}$ of E $\frac{1}{2}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13-75-27, and other lands, and recorded in Madison County Records Deed Record "29" Page "16", said grantee and said grantors being Sarah Lake and Eva. A. Lewis, and William Lewis, the heirs and only heirs of John Lewis deceased.
