One hundred dollars or multiple thereof may be paid at any interest date on and after May 1st, 1927.

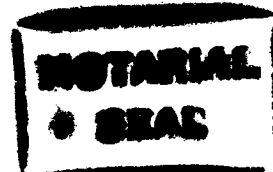
