Ross Moore, a resident of said county and state, being first duly sworn, upon my oath depose and say that I am now the owner of the East Half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northwest Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 18, in Township 76 North, of Range 29 West of the 5th P.M., in Madison County, Iowa, and am the same person as the J. Ross Moore named as grantee in a certain deed from M.L. Silliman, Referee, conveying said land, and recorded in Deed Record 66, at page 81, of the records of said County.

That I am now just 29 years of age. That I have never lived in the Town of Winterset, in said county, nor have I ever had any personal property in said town of Winterset subject to taxation, but that my residence has always been in the vicinity of the Town of Earlham, in said county, and that the personal taxes assessed against one J.R.
