State of Iowa, Cass County, ss: We, and each of us, the undersigned Mary M. Crolley, Francis H. Crolley and T.P. Breheny, being each over the age of twenty one years and being severally and individually upon our oath duly sworn, do each hereby severally swear and state; that we and each of us were well acquainted with John H. Crolley, in his life time and that said John H. Crolley died intestate on the 25th day of November, A.D. 1903, in Cass County, Iowa, in his thirty fourth (34th) year, and at the time of his death was single and that he never had married and died without issue; that at the time of his death he possessed a few horses, and a few farm implements; that the total value of his personal property did not exceed \$1000.00 and that the only real estate which he owned at his death was a one seventh interest in and to the south five and one half acres of the north twenty five acres of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 16-76-26, Crawford Township, Madison County, Iowa, but the funeral expenses and expenses of last sickness of said John H. Crolley were paid in full and equalled the total value of the estate, real and personal, left by the said decedent and we and each of us do further depose and say that James Crolley departed this life in Cass County, Iowa, on the 19th day of April, A.D. 1920, and that the said James Crolley never married during his life time and was single at the time of his death and left no issue him surviving; that at the time of the death of said James Crolley he owned no other real estate than his one sixth interest in the real estate hereinbefore described in this affidavit and that his personal property and estate did not exceed his just debts, funeral expenses and expenses of his

last sickness the sum of \$500.00; that the undersigned Mary M. Crolley is a sister of both the said James Crolley and John H. Crolley and that the undersigned Francis H. Crolley is a brother of said James Crolley and John H. Crolley, and that the said undersigned T.P. Breheny is cashier of the Atlantic National Bank of Atlantic, Iowa, and is a disinterested party, but fully acquainted with the facts and makes this affidavit on his part at the request of the other parties.
