Final Report of Executrix.

Comes now Mary E. Bennett, executrix of the last will and testament of said Andrew Bennett, deceased, and respectfully shows to the court:

That said Andrew Bennett died testate in Madison County, Iowa, on the 14th day of December A.D. 1905 leaving surviving him a widow, who is this executrix, and eight children. That his last will and testament was admitted to probate in this court at the February Term A.D. 1906 of this court and this executrix named as such. That she soon thereafter qualified as such executrix, and caused notice of her appointment as such to be published as required by law more than one year prior to the filing of this report.

That there have been no claims filed against said estate; that all the indebtedness of the estate has been paid in full, and all assets collected so far as known to this executrix; that all court costs have been paid in full, and that there is nothing further requiring the services of this executrix.

That by the terms of the last will and testament all personal property belonging to said decedent was bequeathed absolutely to his widow, this executrix, and that all real estate was bequeathed to her for life, with remainder to his heirs; that this executrix, as the widow of said deceased, has accepted such devise in lieu of dower and distributive share in the property of deceased, and that there is now no distribution of the property of said deceased.

Wherefore she asks that this report be approved by the court; that she be discharged as such executrix, and that all further orders be made by the court that may be necessary in the premises.
