State of Iowa, Madison County, ss: I, P.J.Cunningham a resident of the State and County aforesaid being first duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I am well and personally acquainted with the persons whose names are herein below mentioned, and of my own personal knowledge know the facts as herein set forth.

That Thomas Manguen who entered and to whom was patented the S.½ of the S.E.¼ of Section No. 24, in Township No. 77 North, Range No. 26 West of the 5th P.M. of Iowa, is the same and identical person as the Thomas Manguen who on April 4th 1862, conveyed said land to my father John Cunningham, and that said Thomas Manguen and Margaret Manguen were husband and wife on the date of said conveyance, to-wit: - April 4th 1862.

That John Cunningham and Julia Cunningham were husband and wife on June 9th 1862, at which time they conveyed the above described land to one Thomas Glynn. That in said deed of conveyance the name of said grantee was spelled incorrectly; the same should having been spelled Glynn, instead of Glin.

That the Thomas Glin named in said deed of conveyance, is the same and identical person as the Thomas Glynn who on February 28th 1905, together with his wife Bridget Glynn, executed a mortgage on the above described land to the Des Moines Savings Bank, of Des Moines, Iowa, in the sum of \$1500.00.

That the Debora Horn who cancelled of record the mortgage recorded in Mtg. Record 17 on page 239, is the same and identical as the Deborah Horn, named as mortgagee in said mortgage.

That I am in no way interested in making this affidavit, other than to establish of record the facts as herein set forth.
