IN COURT OF THE COUNTY JUDGE, STATE OF FLORIDA. Palm Beach County, Estate of S.S. Switzer deceased.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING; WHEREAS, S.S. Switzer deceased, late of this County, died intestate, having while he lived at the time of his death, divers goods, chattels and credits within the County aforesaid, by means whereof the full disposition and power of granting the administration of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits of said deceased, and also a final dismissal from the same to the County Judge aforesaid does of right belong.

NOW, Know ye, that I Richard P. Robbins County Judge for the County aforesaid; desiring that the goods, chattels and credits of said deceased may be well and truly administered and legally disposed of, do hereby grant unto Hester J. Switzer as Administratrix full power by the tenor of these presents to administer the goods, chattels and credits of said deceased, which to him in his lifetime and at the time of his death did belong, and to ask, demand, sue for, recover and receive the same, and to pay the debts in which the deceased stood bound, so far as the assets will extend, according to law, and then the balance to pay over to the legal heirs and distributees of said deceased. And the said Hester J. Switzer having given bond and security and taken oath, and performed all other requisites required by law necessary to her just qualification as Administratrix, by order of this Court and virtue of these presents, ordained, constituted and appointed Administratrix of all the goods, chattels and credits of the said S.S. Switzer deceased.
