Said Francis Leitch promises and agrees to pay the same according to the above terms at the office of the Union-Davenport Trust & Savings Bank, Davenport, Iowa.

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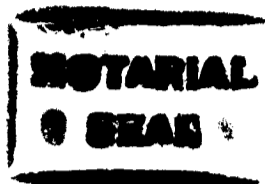

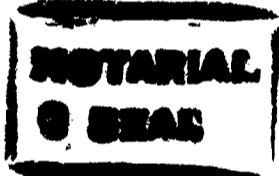
