State of Iowa, Madison County, ss: I, D.H.Hunter, of said State and county, first being duly sworn upon my oath depose and say: That on page 446 of deed record 5 of Madison County, Iowa is the record of a deed executed by Elisabeth Kelly to Nancy Sharp conveying Lot three (3) in Block Five (5) of Langhridge & Cassidays addition to Winterset, Iowa.

That the grantee in said deed was my grandmother and was commonly known as Mary Sharp.

That at the time my grandmother acquired title to said property this affiant was a member of her family and that my grandmother moved upon and occupied said real estate from about the date of said deed, viz:- March 17, 1883, to the date of her death.

That this affiant did at all times from the time my grandmother first began to occupy said property to January 1, 1925, reside in said property.

That W.T.Guher began an action in the District Court of Iowa in and for Madison County, being cause number 13523 and in said cause I alleged that the legal title to said real estate was in Mary Sharp, this was erroneous. I should have alleged in Nancy Sharp, who was commonly known as Mary Sharp.
