STATE OF IOWA, MADISON COUNTY, ss: I, Effie E. Blosser, being first duly sworn do upon my oath depose and say that I am a daughter of Martha Blosser and that of my own personal knowledge I know that Martha Blosser died intestate on the 6 day of December 1920 and that all of her debts have been paid in full and her estate has been distributed among her heirs. I further depose and say that her sole and only heirs at law were myself and my brother, John E. Blosser, and that her husband, Christian E. Blosser died prior to her death.

I further depose and say that I know of my own personal knowledge that Martha Blosser did not assign, transfer, sell or convey her interest during her life time in a certain note and mortgage given by Ward Greenwood and his wife, Maud Greenwood. Said mortgage being dated February 24th, 1919 and recorded in book 65, page 217 of the records of the County Recorder's Office of Madison County, Iowa, and given on the following described real estate: All that part of the Southeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-seven (27) in Township Seventy-six (76) North, Range Twenty-six (26) West of the 5th P.M. lying North of the Right of way of the Chicago, Rock Island & Pacific Railroad as now located across said Quarter Section, Madison County, Iowa, and I further depose and say that the interest of Martha Blosser in said note and mortgage passed by inheritance upon her death to myself and my brother, John E. Blosser.
