AFFIDAVIT

I, W. J. Eisele, being duly sworn, depose and say:

That I am a resident of Madison County, Iowa, and have lived in the vicinity of Earlham Iowa, for more than eighteen years last past; and that I am well acquainted with the following as bounded by the fences as they are now located around said land; described land, to-wit:

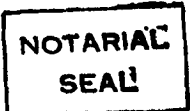
All that part of the West Half of the South West Quarter of Section Five (5), Township 77 North, Range 28 West of the 5th P. M. Iowa, lying north of the right of way of the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railroad Company running East and West through said 80 acres, and the East 37 rods and 17 links of the North East Quarter of the South East Quarter and Lot 3 of the Official Plat of the South Half of the South East Quarter of Section 6, Township 77 North, Range 28 West of the 5th P. M. Iowa, being 108 acres more or less.

That I have been well acquainted with the said land for a period of more than ten years last past; that I have been well and personally acquainted with the several owners who have owned said land for more than ten years last past; and that during all that time the fences around said land, located as they now are, have been recognized as standing on the lines between said land and adjoining lands; and that the present owner of said land, fenced as it now is, and his several grantors, have been in open, notorious, peaceable and uninterrupted possession of said real estate for more than ten years last past.
