I, Lee Stewart, resident of said county and state, being first duly sworn, upon my oath depose and say that I was and am well and personally acquainted with the widow and heirs at law of E. G. Barker (or Elihu G. Barker), deceased.

That the said Elihu G. Barker died, intestate, in Santa Clara County, California, on or about Oct. 14, 1918, and that a transcript of the proceedings in his estate was filed in Madison County, Iowa, on Apr. 5, 1919.

That Alice L. Barker was the surviving widow of said E. G. Barker (or Elihu G. Barker) and that Gem Barker Davis, Maude Barker Neff and Guy Barker were his sole and only heirs at law; and that the Gem Barker Davis named in said transcript as one of such heirs at law, is the same and identical person as the Gem Barker Jenkins who is named as one of the grantors in a certain quit claim deed running to A. P. Stewart, which is recorded at page 440 of Deed Record 55, of the records in the office of the Recorder of Madison County, Iowa. That the Maud Neff, named in said deed as one of the grantors, is the same person as the Maude Barker Neff, named in said transcript.

That Alice L. Barker, one of the grantors in said deed recorded in Deed record 55, at page 440 thereof, was at the date of the execution thereof, a widow, and unmarried; that Guy Barker and Cora Barker, grantors named in said deed, were, at the date of the execution thereof, husband and wife; that Gem Barker Jenkins and Hubert Jenkins, grantors named in said deed, were at the date of the execution thereof, wife and husband, and that Maud Neff and Charles Neff, grantors named in said deed, were at the date of the execution thereof, wife and

husband, and that the spelling of the name of Hubert Jenkins in said deed as Herbert Jenkin was a clerical error on the part of the person who drew the same.

That this affidavit is made for the sole purpose of correcting apparent discrepancies in names of parties as above set forth.
