A G R E E M E N T F O R E X T E N S I O N .

WHEREAS, Frank Jacobe and Minnie L. Jacobe husband and wife, did on the 1st day of Feb. 1922 execute and deliver to the Davenport Savings Bank of Davenport, Iowa, ascertain mortgage which was recorded in book 74 page 251 of the records of Madison County, Iowa to secure the payment of a certain note in the sum of \$6000.00 and interest; now J. C. Crocheck and Birdie Crocheck, his wife, the present owners of the premises described in said mortgage, and the UNION SAVINGS BANK AND TRUST COMPANY of Davenport, Iowa, the present owner of said note and mortgage, do by these presents agree that the principal sum due is \$6000.00 and that the same shall bear interest at the rate of 5½ per cent per annum, from Mar. 1, 1927, payable semi-annually, on the 1st day of September and the 1st day of March of each year and the principal sum shall become due on the 1st day of March, 1932, at which time the said J. C. Crocheck and Birdie Crocheck his wife, hereby assume and agree to pay the same with interest at the office of the UNION SAVINGS BANK AND TRUST COMPANY of Davenport, Iowa.

\$200.00 is to be paid on the principal on Mar. 1, 1928, and \$200000 on March 1st of each year thereafter.

It is further agreed that all the terms, conditions and stipulations contained in said note and mortgage shall continue in full force and effect excepting only as modified by this agreement.
