I, Will Cochran, a resident of said county and state, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath depose and say that I am the same and identical person as the Will Cochran, who acted as administrator of the estates of the late Antipas Simpson and Harriet A. Simpson, and am the same and identical person as the Will Cochran who was appointed Sole Referee in the partition action entitle John B. Simpson, Plaintiff vs. Lydia Rhone, et al, which is now pending in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa.

That I was well acquainted with both the said Antipas Simpson and his wife, Harriet A. Simpson, and with all of their children and heirs at law, and that the statements herein after contained are made from personal knowledge.

That the said Antipas Simpson died on or about Jan 6, 1921, testate, seized in fee of the North 30 acres of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 29, and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ & NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 30-74-27 (and other land).
