## AFFIDAVIT

I, Will Cochran, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I was personally acquainted with Alexander H. Wilson who died intestate in Madison County, Iowa, prior to August 31<sup>st</sup>, 1916, seized of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 9 and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  & S $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  & SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 10 and a right of way across the Northwest corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 10, all in 74-28, and that the estate of the said Alexander H. Wilson was fully settled without the appointment of an administrator.

I further depose and say that the said Alexander H. Wilson left surviving him his widow, Sarah E. Wilson, and as his only child and heir at law his son, Walter I. Wilson; and that the said Walter I. Wilson conveyed all his interest in the above described land to his mother, the said Sarah E.
