I, Alonzo E. Gabbert, of said State and County, first being duly sworn upon my oath depose and say:-

That I am a son of Jacob Gabbert and Mary Jane Gabbert, and a brother of Michael R. Gabbert, commonly known as M. R. Gabbert, deceased, late of Madison County, Iowa. That Jacob Gabbert, the father of M. R. Gabbert, died testate on or about April 23, 1880, leaving surviving him Mary Jane Gabbert, mother of M. R. Gabbert, his widow, and the will of said Jacob Gabbert was probated in Madison County, Iowa. That the sole devisees and heirs at law of the said Jacob Gabbert were his widow, Mary Jane Gabbert who died January 30, 1913, and his eleven children, to-wit:

Thomas G. Gabbert, Michael R. Gabbert, James Gabbert, George Gabbert, Alonzo E. Gabbert, this affiant, Sarah E. Gowin, Emma M. Conway, Belle Gabbert, Harriet E. Gabbert, Martha L. Gabbert and Effie Gabbert; and each of the said children of the said Jacob Gabbert were the children of Mary Jane Gabbert.

That the said Martha L. Gabbert became the wife of A. W. Myers, and that the said Emma Gabbert became the wife of William Conway, and that the said Martha L. Myers and Emma Conway, each died intestate prior to the death of the said Mary Jane Gabbert, leaving surviving them issue and their said husbands.

That the said George Gabbert and James Gabbert, who was the same person as J. O. Gabbert, two of the sons of the said Mary Jane Gabbert, each died intestate, unmarried and without issue, prior to the death of the said Mary Jane Gabbert.

That the said Mary Jane Gabbert died intestate and unmarried on or about January 30th, 1913 and her estate was probated in Madison County, Iowa, leaving surviving her as her sole heirs at law, the said Thomas G. Gabbert, Michael R. Gabbert, Alonzo E. Gabbert, this affiant, Sarah E. Gowin, Belle Gabbert Morgan, Harriet E. Gabbert Foster and Effie Gabbert (now Jones), her surviving children, and the heirs at law of Martha L. Myers and Emma Conway, who were
