## AFFIDAVIT.

State of Iowa, Madison County, SS

I, C.C. Cook, being first duly sworn on oath state that I was well acquainted with Ralph W. Black, sometimes signed R.W. Black, from the year 1915 to on or about the first day of March 1920 and that I know it to be a fact and now so state that during all of said time that I was personally acquainted with said Ralph W. Black he was a farmer residing in Madison County, Iowa; that said Ralph W. Black ( R.W. Black one and the same person ) was from on or about the 2nd day of March, 1918, to on or about the 26th day of February, 1920, the owner of record of the following described real estate to wit: N.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  and N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 32, also S.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$ , of Section 29, all in Township 77 North, Range 26, West of the 5th P. M., in Madison County, Iowa; that during the year 1919 said Ralph W. Black was about 33 years of age; that the Ralph Black against whom a judgment was entered in the United States District Court, Southern District, Central Division at Des Moines, Iowa, in the sum of \$300.00 and costs on January 29, 1919, was an entirely different person from the Ralph W. Black, (R.W. Black) whose name appears in the record of the real estate above described; and that the Ralph Black against whom the above mentioned judgment was rendered was never the owner of the above described real estate.
