AFFIDAVIT.

I, B. C. Blythe, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with William H. Weeks who died intestate in Madison County, Iowa, on March 29th 1915, and whose estate is entered in Probate Docket "G", page 37, and with all the members of his family, and know that he was the same and identical person as the William Weeks to whom Lewis Bradley and wife Sarah Bradley conveyed the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 5 & NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 8, in Twp. 74, Range 28, by deed dated March 15th 1859 and recorded in Record "L", page 7.

I further depose and say that the Mary A. Weeks who is named in the registry of heirs filed in the estate of the said William H. Weeks was the surviving widow of said William H. Weeks, and was the same and identical person as the Mary A. Weeks whose estate is entered in Probate Docket "I", page 193; and that the Henry Weeks named in the registry of heirs of the said William H. Weeks was the same and identical person as the H. H. Weeks who is named in the registry of heirs in the estate of the said Mary A. Weeks.

I further depose and say that in all conveyances of any of the real estate of which the said William H. Weeks or the said Mary A. Weeks died seized, or in any instruments or proceedings affecting any of said real estate, Henry Weeks was the same and identical person as H. H. Weeks; that A. B. Weeks was the same and identical person as Alva B. Weeks; that W. E. Weeks was the same and identical person as William E. Weeks; and that C. C. Weeks was the same and identical person as Clyde C. Weeks; all of the above mentioned records being of Madison County, Iowa.

I further state that I have no interest in making this affidavit except to establish the above facts of record.
