AFFIDAVIT

I, M. C. Leinard, a resident of Madison County, Iowa, being first duly sworn, upon my oath depose and say that I am well and personally acquainted with Martin J. Smith who, with his wife, Rosa Smith, owns of record the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ except that part thereof lying South of Middle River, all in Section 15, in Township 75 North, of Range 28 West of the 5th P. M.

That to my personal knowledge the full name of the said Martin J. Smith is Martin Johnson Smith.

That to my personal knowledge, the said Martin J. Smith was born and raised in Lincoln Township, in said county, has resided in said township continuously since his birth and has never lived in any other township or town in said county nor had personal property located any place except in said Lincoln Township subject to taxation.

That the records of the County Treasurer of said county show delinquent personal taxes assessed against one M. J. Smith in Union Township for the years 1890, 1892, and 1897, and in Winterset for the years 1900, 1901, 1902, 1903, 1895, 1896, 1897, 1898, 1899, 1900, 1901, 1903, and 1906, and in Crawford Township for the year 1903, and against Smith & Kephart in Grand River Township for the year 1902, and against Smith & Pahre Dell in South Township for the year 1923, but that the said Martin J. Smith is not the M. J. Smith against whom said taxes are assessed, nor was he a member of the firm of Smith & Kephart, or of the firm of Smith & Pahre Dell, and that said delinquent personal taxes so assessed and of record are due and owing from some person other than the said Martin J. Smith and are not now and never have been a lien against the land first herein described or any other real estate owned by the said Martin J. Smith.

That I am in no way interested, but make this affidavit for the purpose of establishing of record the facts hereinabove set forth.
