## AFFIDAVIT

I, Martin J. Smith, a resident of Madison County, Iowa, being first duly sworn, upon my oath depose and say that I am, with my wife, the owner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  & the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  except that part thereof lying South of Middle River, all in Section 15, in Township 75 North, of Range 28, West of the 5th P. M.

That my full name is Martin Johnson Smith.

That I was born and raised in Lincoln Township, in said County.

That I have resided continuously in said Lincoln Township since my birth.

That I have never resided in any other township in said county nor in any town in said county.

That I have never had personal property of any description located in any township or town, other than said Lincoln Township, subject to taxation.

That I am informed that the records of the County Treasurer of said county show delinquent personal taxes assessed against one M. J. Smith in Union Township for the years 1890, 1892 and 1897, and in Winterset for the years 1900, 1901, 1902, 1905, 1895, 1896, 1897, 1898, 1899, 1900, 1901, 1903 and 1906, and in Crawford Township for the year 1903, and against Smith & Kephart in Grand River Township for the year 1902, and against Smith & Pahre Dell in South Township for the year 1923, but that I am not the M. J. Smith against whom said taxes are assessed nor have I at any time been a member of the firm of Smith & Kephart nor of the firm of Smith & Pahre Dell.

That said personal taxes so assessed are due and owing from some other person or persons than this affiant, and the same are not now and never have been a lien upon the real estate above described or upon any other land owned by this affiant.

That at one time there was an M. J. Smith who resided in Madison County, Iowa, but he is now deceased.
