I, Adam Busch, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with E. G. Barker and with his wife, Alice L. Barker, who joined in the plat of Barker's Second Addition to Macksburg, Iowa, shown in Town Plat Book 1, page 140, of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and with the members of their family. That the said E. G. Barker, also known as Elihu G. Barker, died intestate in Santa Clara County, California, about October 14th, 1918, as shown by a duly certified transcript from said county filed in Madison County, Iowa, on April 5th, 1919 and entered in Probate docket "G", page 367, of the records of said county. That the said E. G. Barker left surviving him his widow, the above named Alice L. Barker, and as his only children and heirs at law, Guy Barker, Maude Barker Neff and Gem Barker Jenkins, all of full age, and that the said Maude Barker Neff was the same and identical person as the Maude Neff who joined as one of the grantors in a certain deed recorded in Town Lot Deed Record 28, page 433. That the above named Alice L.
