I, J. M. Grandfield, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I am a son of J. C. Grandfield who is named as grantee in a certain deed recorded in Deed Record 16, page 609, and know that he was the same and identical person as the John C. Grandfield who is named as grantee in a certain deed recorded in Record "O", page 124; as the J. C. Grandfield who is named as grantee in a certain deed recorded in Deed Record 30, page 112; as the John C. Grandfield who is named as grantee in a certain deed recorded in Deed Record 15, page 230; as the J. C. Grandfield who is named as grantee in a certain deed recorded in Deed Record 16, page 324; as the John C. Grandfield who is named as grantee in a certain deed recorded in Deed Record 17, page 10; and as the J. C. Grandfield who died intestate in Madison County, Iowa, on May 9<sup>th</sup>, 1896, as shown by the Probate Records of said county.

I further depose and say that the Elizabeth Grandfield, widow, and Alice E. Stearns, Rosa M. Porter, Ada L. Logsdon, Joseph M. Grandfield, John W. Grandfield, Oscar M. Grandfield, Oliver A.
