## EXTENSION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, George B. Lane and Minnie Lane, husband and wife; May and Lafayette M. Lane did on the 10th day of May 1910, execute and deliver to Bankers Life Company a certain mortgage which was recorded in Book 69 on Page 445 of the records of Warren County and Book 49 Page 601 of Madison County records, State of Iowa, to secure the payment of one certain note, and interest thereon, described as follows, to-wit: Note for \$4000.00, due May 1, 1915 and extended to May 1, 1930 and

WHEREAS, the following note above mentioned still remain unpaid, viz: Note for \$4000.00, due May 1, 1915 and extended to May 1, 1930.

Now, George B. Lane, a widower the present owner of the premises described in said mortgage, and the Bankers Life Company, the present owner of said mortgage and said note last herein above mentioned, do by these presents agree that the principal sum due and unpaid on said note and mortgage is Four Thousand (\$4000.00) and no/100 DOLLARS and that the same shall bear interest at the rate of 5-1/2 per cent, per annum, from May 1, 1930, payable semi-annually, on the first days of May and November of each year, and that said unpaid principal sum shall become due as follows, to-wit: \$4000.00 on May 1, 1935., and the said George B. Lane, a widower hereby assumes and agrees to pay the same, with interest, at the office of the Bankers Life Company, at Des Moines, Iowa.

It is further agreed that all the terms, conditions and stipulations contained in said note and mortgage shall continue in full force and effect excepting only as modified by this agreement.

One hundred dollars or multiples thereof may be paid on said debt at any interest paying date on and after May 1, 1932.
