ASSIGNMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT, the undersigned, The Reinsurance Life Company of America, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of Iowa, with offices in the City of Des Moines, County of Polk and State of Iowa, the party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of one (\$1.00) Dollar, lawful money of the United States of America, to it in hand paid by The Reinsurance Life Company of America, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of Illinois, with executive offices in the City of Chicago, County of Cook and State of Illinois, the party of the second part, at or before the ensealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, transferred and set over, and, by these Presents, does grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the said party of the second part its successors and assigns, a certain Indenture of Mortgage, bearing date the thirteenth day of June in the year One Thousand Nine Hundred twenty-four made by James Brown, Howard Brown and May G. Brown and all its right, title and interest to the premises therein described, as follows, to-wit:

West one-half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of southwest quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section twenty-two (22),

Township seventy-four (74), Range Twenty-nine (29) in Madison County, Iowa,

which said Mortgage is recorded in the Recorder's Office of the County of Madison in the State of Iowa in Book No. 75 at page 535.

Together with the note or notes therein described, and the money due or to grow due thereon with the interest, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever, subject only to the provisos in the said Indenture of Mortgage contained;

And the undersigned does hereby make, constitute and appoint the said party of the second part its true and lawful Attorney, irrevocably, in its name, or otherwise, but at its own proper costs and charges, to have, use, and take all lawful ways and means for the recovery of the said money and interest, and, in case of payment, to discharge the same as fully as it might, or could do, if these presents were not made.
