It is further agreed that all the terms, conditions and stipulations contained in said note..and mortgage shall continue in full force and effect excepting only as modified by this agreement.

One hundred dollars or multiples thereof may be paid on said debt at any interest paying date on and after March 1, 1933

And the undersigned, in consideration of the execution of the above and foregoing extension agreement, by the Bankers Life Company, hereby agree to paint the buildings located on the land covered by said mortgage in good, workmanlike manner during the summer of the year 1931, such painting to be completed not later than October 1,1931.
