AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF MORTGAGE

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on the principal of said note the sum of Three thousand five hundred & 00/100 (\$3,500.00) DOLLARS, and,

WHEREAS, the said Arthur T. Black & Hattie F. Black has agreed with the holder of said note to extend the time of payment thereon,

MOW THEREFOR, the said Arthur T. Black & Hattie F. Black hereby agrees to pay on the 1st day of March A. D., 1935, the said principal sum of Three thousand five hundred & 00/100 (\$3,500.00) DOLLARS, remaining unpaid on the said note and mortgage, with privilege of paying One hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or any multiple thereof at any time. with interest from March 1, 1932 at the rate of 5th per cent per annum payable annually on the first day of March in each year both principal and interest payable at Des Moines; and the said Arthur T. Black & Hattie F.
