EXTENSION AGREEMENT.

That there is still unpaid upon the notes secured by said mortgage the sum of Four Thousand Three Hundred Forty-five & 50/100 (\$4345.50) Dollars, as principal, and that the interest due March 1st, 1933, viz: Two Hundred Thirty-nine (\$239.00) Dollars is unpaid, which sums said first party hereby promises to pay and discharge when they shall become due, as below stated, with all costs and expense, as well as interest accrued or to accrue, said unpaid interest to bear interest at the rate of six (6%) per cent per annum, and to be payable on or before May 15th, 1933; and,
