EXTENSION AGREEMENT.

THIS AGREEMENT, Made and entered into this 11th day of March, A. D. 1933, by and between T. P. O'Loughlin, the owner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 27-76-28, party of the first part, and Priscilla M. Kinsman and Faith D. Kinsman, owners of the notes secured by a mortgage on said land, which mortgage is recorded on page 47 in Book 71 of the records of the County Recorder of Madison County, Iowa, parties of the second part, WITNESSETH: That said parties afore-said have agreed and do hereby agree concerning the indebtedness secured by said mortgage as follows, to-wit:

That there is still unpaid upon the notes secured by said mortgage the sum of Four Thousand Three Hundred Forty-five & 50/100 (\$4345.50) Dollars, as principal, and that the interest due March 1st, 1933, viz: Two Hundred Thirty-nine (\$239.00) Dollars is unpaid, which sums said first party hereby promises to pay and discharge when they shall become due, as below stated, with all costs and expense, as well as interest accrued or to accrue, said unpaid interest to bear interest at the rate of six (6%) per cent per annum, and to be payable on or before May 15th, 1933; and,

That the unpaid principal of said note, viz: \$4345.50, is hereby extended to March 1st, 1938, bearing interest at five and one-half (5 $\frac{1}{2}$ %) per cent per annum payable annually.

That first party has the right to pay any amount at any time by paying the interest on the sum paid from the last interest date to the time of payment.

That all other stipulations and provisions in said notes and mortgage, not herein changed, are expressly kept in full force.
