KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That for a good and valuable consideration, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, THE CHASE NATIONAL BANK OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK, as Trustee, does hereby fully release and discharge from the lien of a certain mortgage executed by the Natural Gas Pipeline Company of America to The Chase National Bank of the City of New York, as Trustee, under date of October 15, 1931, which mortgage was filed for record January 16, 1932 and recorded in Book 70, on page 1, of the Mortgage Records of Madison County, Iowa, the real estate described as follows, to-wit:
