Assignment of Real Estate
Contract

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the BANKERS LIFE COMPANY of the County of Polk and State of Iowa, a corporation organized and existing under the Laws of Iowa, in consideration of Ray Murphy, Commissioner of Insurance of the State of Iowa, accepting the contract hereby assigned as a part of the deposit required by Section 8655 of the Code of Iowa of 1931, does hereby assign unto the said Ray Murphy, as Commissioner of Insurance of the State of Iowa, and to his successors in office, in their official capacity, for deposit as hereinafter described, all its right, title and interest in and to that certain real estate contract entered into on the 18th day of February, 1936, by and between said Bankers Life Company, as party of the first part, and Howard Dean, a single man, as party of the second part, for the sale of the following

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described real estate situated in Madison County, State of Iowa, to-wit:

And the said Bankers Life Company hereby covenants with the said Ray Murphy, as Commissioner of Insurance of the State of Iowa, and his successors in office, that it holds good and perfect legal title to said premises, free and clear of all encumbrances; and that it is the absolute owner of the vendor's interest in and to said contract, and has good right and lawful authority to assign the same.

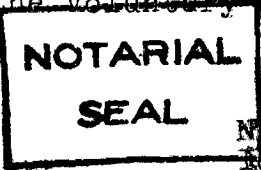
