## EXTENSION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, John W. Graves and Nannie Graves, husband and wife, did on the 15th day of February 1930, execute and deliver to Bankers Life Company a certain mortgage which was recorded in Book 80 on Page 456 of the records of Madison County, State of Iowa, to secure the payment of five certain notes and interest thereon, described as follows, to-wit: Note for \$500.00 due March 1, 1931, Note for \$500.00 due March 1, 1932, Note for \$500.00 due March 1, 1933, Note for \$500.00 due March 1, 1934, Note for \$18,000.00 due March 1, 1935, and

WHEREAS, the following notes above mentioned still remain unpaid, viz: Note for \$500.00 due March 1, 1934, Note for \$18,000.00 due March 1, 1935,

Now, John W. Graves and Nannie Graves, husband and wife, and J. Earl Graves and Madalene Graves, husband and wife, the present owners of the premises described in said mortgage, hereinafter called "first parties," and the Bankers Life Company, the present owner of said mortgage and said note last herein above mentioned, hereinafter called "second party," do by these presents agree that the principal sum due and unpaid on said note and mortgage is Eighteen Thousand Five Dollars and that the same shall bear interest at the rate of 4- $\frac{1}{2}$  per cent, per annum, from March 1, 1936, payable semi-annually, on the first days of March and September of each year, and that said unpaid principal sum shall become due as follows, to-wit: \$150.00 on Sept. 1, 1936, \$150.00 on March 1, 1937, \$150.00 on Sept. 1, 1937, \$150.00 on March 1, 1938, \$150.00 on Sept. 1, 1938, \$150.00 on March 1, 1939, \$150.00 on Sept. 1, 1939, \$150.00 on March 1, 1940, \$150.00 on Sept. 1, 1940, \$250.00 on March 1, 1941, \$250.00 on Sept. 1, 1941, \$250.00 on March 1, 1942, \$250.00 on Sept. 1, 1942, \$250.00 on March 1, 1943, \$250.00 on Sept. 1, 1943, \$250.00 on March 1, 1944, \$250.00 on Sept. 1, 1944, \$250.00 on March 1, 1945, \$250.00 on Sept. 1, 1945, \$14,650.00 on March 1, 1946, past due principal and interest to bear interest at 7% per annum; and the said first parties hereby assume and agree to pay the same, with interest, at the office of the Bankers Life Company, at Des Moines, Iowa.

In consideration of said extension of time of payment of said principal sum, said first parties hereby sell, convey and mortgage to said second party all the crops now growing and at any time hereafter grown on the real estate covered by said mortgage hereinabove mentioned from the date of this agreement until the terms of said note and mortgage, except as modified by this agreement, are complied with and fulfilled; said real estate being described as follows to-wit:

The West half of the Southeast quarter and the East half of the Southwest quarter and the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter and the South ten (10) acres of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter and the South thirty (30) acres of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section Seventeen (17) in Township Seventy-five (75) North, of Range Twenty-seven (27) West of the 5th P.M. in Madison County, Iowa.

It is agreed that if said first parties fail to keep and perform any of the agreements of said note and mortgage except as modified by this agreement, or cause or suffer/ default therein or thereof in any respect, the said second party, either before commencement of suit or at any time thereafter, shall be entitled to the possession of said property real and personal and to the appointment of a receiver, who shall have power to take and hold possession of all of said property, to rent the same, and to collect the rents and profits therefrom for the benefit of said second party, and such receiver shall be appointed upon the application of said second party at any time after default of said first parties in any of the provisions of said note and mortgage, except as modified by this agreement, either independently of or in connection with the commencement of foreclosure or when suit is begun

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or at any time thereafter, and such right shall in no event be barred, forfeited or retarded by reason ~~by reason~~ of delay or of a judgment, decree, or sale ordered in any suit, and, further such right to have such receiver appointed upon application of said second party shall exist regardless of the solvency or insolvency of said first parties, or any of them, or of their successors or assigns, and irrespective of the value of said premises, or of the amount of waste, loss or destruction of the premises or of the rents and profits thereof. Such taking of possession by the receiver shall in no way retard collection or the institution of suit. The receiver shall be held to account only for the net profits derived from said property.

Said first parties agree to keep all buildings on said premises continually insured against loss and damage by fire and windstorm in some responsible company or companies satisfactory to said second party, in such sums as approved by said second party, and to deliver all policies in force and all renewal receipts to said second party; and if such insurance is not so kept in force, said first parties agree that said second party may effect such insurance, and that any sums paid therefor by said second party, with interest at 7% per annum, shall become part of the debt secured by said mortgage hereinabove mentioned.

It is further agreed that all the terms conditions and stipulations contained in said note and mortgage shall continue in full force and effect excepting only as modified by this agreement. "Privilege is given to make payments on principal sum of this note in multiples of \$100 on any date, but the total of such payments shall not exceed an amount equal to one-fifth of the original principal sum of this note during any twelve months' period, beginning March 1, 1936, This privilege is not cumulative,"
