but hereby expressly retaining the lien under its said mortgage as to the remainder of the real estate described in and covered thereby.

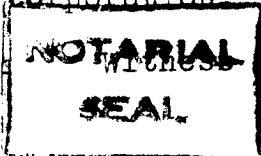
