Whereas, T. P. O'Loughlin is the present owner of the property described in said mortgage, and the Union State Bank, Winterset, Iowa, the present owner of said note and mortgage, have this day agreed to extend the time of payment of the balance due of the principal sum of said note secured by said mortgage;

Now, Therefore, for Value Received, it is hereby agreed that the principal sum now fully and justly unpeid on the note secured by said mortgage is Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollers and and is to draw that the same draws/interest at the rate of five per cent per annum, to be computed from the 15th day of October, 1940, and the said principal sum shall become due and payable as follows, to-wit: October 15th, 1945, at which time herein set forth, the party of the first part hereby assumes and agrees to pay and discharge same with all costs and expenses as well as interest accrued or to accrue at the Union State Bank at Winterset, Iowa, and the party of the second part does by these presents consent and agree to the extension of said mortgage indebtedness as above set-forth;

It is also mutually agreed that all the terms, conditions and stipulations in said note and mortgage contained and set forth are and shall continue in full force and effect, excepting only as modified by the foregoing agreement;
