Lieut. (Army serial No. 0-456004) in the Army of the United States, and anticipating that I may be required to go overseas in said military service, have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint Louise Elderkin, whose address is Winterset, Iowa, my true and lawful attorney to act in, manage and conduct all my estate and all my affairs, and for that purpose for me and in my name, place, and stead, and for my use and benefit, and as my act and deed, to do and execute, or to concur. With persons jointly interested with myself therein in the doing or executing of, all or any of the following sets, deeds, and things, that is to say:
