AFFIDAVIT Rex Johnson and Eugene Wilson, to the Public

State of Iowa, Madison County, ss: To Whom It May Concern:

We, Rex Johnson, and Eugene Wilson, both being duly sworn, depose and say: that we are each residents of Madison County, Iowa; that we are acquainted with David L. Campbell, of Madison County, Iowa, and also were acquainted with Clara J. Campbell, the wife of said David L. Campbell in her lifetime; that we know that said Clara J. Campbell is dead, and that she died, intestate, on the 28th day of March, 1940, and that at the time of her death she was a resident of Madison County, Iowa, and that she left as her surviving spouse said David L. Campbell, and as her only heirs at law her children, as follows: Lester Clyde Campbell, intermarried with Ethel Campbell; Carl Campbell, intermarried with Gladys Campbell; Lennie M., also known as L.
