For good consideration, The Federal Land Bank of Omaha, a corporation of Omaha, Nebraska, and the Land Bank Commissioner and the Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation, as their interests may appear, by The Federal Land Bank of Omaha, their Agent and Attorney-in-fact, do hereby release from the lien of their mortgages the following described property:
