AFFIDAVIT

State of Iowa, Madison County, ss.

I, Lyle Archer, being sworn, depose and say as follows: That I am a grandson of the James Adrian who died on or about Feb. 6, 1934, intestate, seized of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34 and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, in Township 74 North, of Range 28 West of the 5th P.M., and whose estate was administered in the District Court of Union County, Iowa, a transcript of the proceedings had therein having been filed in the office of the Clerk of the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, on Jan. 10, 1935. That the said James Adrian left him surviving, his wife, Martha Alice Adrian, and as his sole and only heirs at

That the said Martha Alice Adrian was the same person as the Marthe Adrian, who died, testate, on or about Apr. 9, 1935, and whose estate was administered in the District Court of Union County, Iowa, a transcript of the proceedings had therein having been filed in the office of the Clerk of the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, on May 26, 1936. That the said Martha (or Martha Alice) Adrian left no spouse surviving, and that her sole and only devisees were her grandsons, Alonzo J. Archer, James A. Archer, Wendell Archer, William B. Archer, Lyle Archer and Benjamin Archer.
