I state that I am personally sequainted with the title, possession and ownership of the following described real estate located in Madison County, Iowa, to-wit:

The Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, and the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 24, Township 77 North, Range 28, West of the Fifth P.M.,

which property belonged to my grandfather, Michael E. White, Sr., for many years prior to his death on or about July 18, 1881, and which property was subsequently conveyed by his widow and heirs to William D. Fisher shortly after the death of said Michael E. White, Sr., and

The Northesst Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 24, Township 77 North, Range 28 West of the Fifth P.M.,

which property was purchased by W. D. Fisher on August 25, 1882, and recorded in Deed Record 20, at Page 533, in the office of the Recorder of Medison County, Iowa, and that the said W. D. Fisher who purchased said property is one and the same person as William D. Fisher who purchased the property from the widow and heirs-at-law of Michael E. White, Sr., on or about the same time.

This effiant further states that I know/Ella Brand and Florence Scott, present title owners, of the above described real estate, and their mother, Mary E. Fisher, and their father W. D. Fisher, and their grantors, immediate or remote, in the chain of title to said real estate, have been in open, continuous, notorious, adverse and undisturbed possession of said real estate for a period of more than 60 years, and that no person, firm or corporation has during said period, claimed or esserted any interest in said real estate adverse to or in opposition to the claim, right, title and possession by the said Ella Brand and Florence Scott, and their grantors, immediate and remote, in the chain of title to said real estate.

That the Marie Sheild named in the Will of W. D. Fisher is one and the same person as Marie Shield thereinafter referred to in said estate of W. D. Fisher, and one and the same person as Marie Shields named in the last Will and Testament of Mary E. Fisher, and in her estate proceedings; and that Winford Sheild named in the Will of W. D. Fisher is one and the same person as Winford Shield thereinafter referred to in said Estate of W. D. Fisher; and one and the same person as Winfred F. Shields named in the last Will and Testament of Mary E. Fisher, and in her estate proceedings.
