GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT I, Denver Piatt, whose legal address is RFD #1, Mt. Pleasant, Iowa, now in the Army of the United States, as Private, ASN 37 696 456, being desirous of appointing an attorney-in-fact, to act for me and on my behalf on all matters of which I may have an interest, do hereby make, constitute and appoint my wife, Virginia L. Piatt, RFD #1, Mt. Pleasant, Henry County, Iowa, my true and lawful attorney-in-fact, with full and complete power and authority to pledge, mortgage or execute deeds of trust for, sell, lease, let, transfer, assign, exchange or otherwise encumber or dispose of any or all my property, real, personal or mixed on such terms and under such conditions she may deem proper, and to execute and deliver good and sufficient instruments for the accomplishment thereof and to receive and receipt for the proceeds or security therefor; to collect, sue upon, compromise or otherwise adjust any claim, debt, bequest, devise, inheritance or cause of action, whether in law or equity, in which I now or hereafter may have an interest, including authority expressly given hereby to sign for me and on my behalf any or all vouchers for pay and allowances or for other monies now due or to become due me from the Government of the United States, or any branch thereof, or from any other person or corporation, and to receive, indorse, and collect checks or other negotiable instruments payable to me drawn on the Treasurer of the United States, or any bank or banking corporation, for whatever account, and to give full

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discharge therefor; to pay, compromise, or otherwise discharge and secure releases from any obligations or claims; to deposit in my name and for my account with any bank, banker or trust company any check or other negotiable instrument, including those drawn on the Treasurer of the United States, which may come to her hands as such attorney, and all monies, bills of exchange, drafts, promissory notes, and other securities for money payable or belonging to me, and for the purpose aforesaid to sign my name and indorse the same for deposit or collection, and from time to time to withdraw any and all monies deposited with the aforesaid depositories or any other depository, now or hereafter having monies belonging to me, and for that purpose to draw checks in my name;

To waive service of or accept any legal process or summons, or to enter my appearance in, any probate or estate proceedings in any Probate or Chancery Court, in any cause therein where I am a necessary party, including the right to receive and execute full release for any disbursements which might be due me therein.

FURTHER, I do authorize my aforesaid attorney-in-fact to perform all acts incidental and necessary to the execution of the aforesaid authorizations, and I do hereby expressly declare that the powers herein granted to my aforesaid attorney-in-fact shall not be construed as limited to those matters hereinbefore specifically set forth but rather shall be construed to broadly include and embrace full and unlimited power of an^d authority to do and perform, on my behalf and in my place and stead and with equal validity, any and all other lawful acts or things which I could do if personally present; hereby ratifying and confirming whatsoever my said attorney shall and may do, by virtue hereof, in the premises.
